Terms and conditions

These terms and conditions apply to all participants on a Common Purpose Frontrunner programme.

Attendance and programmes

- A place on the Common Purpose Frontrunner programme is subject to acceptance of the application by the Common Purpose Advisory Group.
- A participant on a Common Purpose Frontrunner programme undertakes to attend for the full duration of the programme.
- If a participant, having started the programme, then withdraws from the programme for any reason, it is not guaranteed that the participant will be allowed by Common Purpose to resume attendance.
- If a participant misses any part of the programme due to absenteeism, this may affect whether Common Purpose confers graduate status upon the participant.
- Common Purpose retains the right to change the advertised agenda for a Common Purpose Frontrunner programme day or event without notice to the participants.
- Participants will be given reasonable notice in advance if the venue for a Common Purpose Frontrunner programme or event is changed.

Conduct during the programme

- When booking and paying for a Common Purpose programme day or event venue (including the accommodation), Common Purpose is acting as an agent on the participants' behalf. Participants will be subject to the terms and conditions of the venue.
- It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that while attending the Common Purpose Frontrunner programme and while on any third party premises he or she does not behave in an improper or disorderly manner or in a way which risks or causes damage to property, or in a way which is in breach of the terms and conditions of those premises.
