Three Dot Dash Global Teen Leader (GTL) Nomination Procedure

ALL GTL Nominations Must Be Received By: **September 15, 2007**
Selected GTL Participants and Alternates will be notified by: **October 31, 2007**

Three Dot Dash Global Teen Leader Nominee Eligibility:

Three Dot Dash is looking for 25 – 30 Global Teen Leaders (GTL) who are doing extraordinary work that helps meet the basic human needs – food, water, health, shelter, education and safety – thus creating a more peaceful society:

GTLs must meet **ALL** of the following requirements to be nominated and to participate in Three Dot Dash:

- Be nominated by a non-governmental organization (NGO) or other qualified organization*.
- Be between the ages of 13 – 19 at the time of the 2008 Summit (March 29 – April 4).
- Must have a demonstrated track record of leadership within their communities and/or globally that has significantly affected the basic human needs of others with regard to one or more of the following: food, water, health, shelter, education and safety.
- Speak and write English proficiently.
- Be able to travel to the United States to participate in the 2008 Summit.
- Be accompanied by a guardian to the 2008 Summit if under the age of 18.

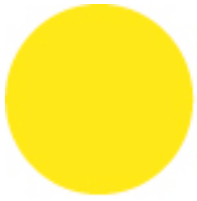
Other Important Information:

- 25 – 30 Global Teen Leaders will be chosen to participate in Three Dot Dash 2008.
- You may nominate more than one GTL to Three Dot Dash.
- Nomination does not guarantee acceptance to Three Dot Dash.
- Ten (10) GTLs will be selected as “Alternates” in case chosen GTLs are unable to participate.
- Three Dot Dash’s Just Peace Summit is hosted by the We Are Family Foundation (WAFF). Travel, hotel, food and monetary stipend will be provided by WAFF for each GTL participant.

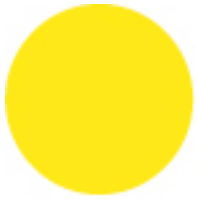

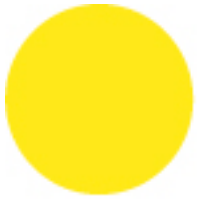
