### Junior Category – Grades 6, 7, 8

- **Who?**  
Open to students in grades 6, 7, and 8
- **What?**  
Film a 2 minute video with 1-4 of your friends (groups of 2-5 people) answering the question “What kind of world do you want to live in and what will it take to get there?”. You can also include a 250 word write-up explaining the video.  
Or...share your vision of a better world through images. Answer the question “What kind of world do you want to live in and what will it take to get there?” through photograph collage and through a write-up of 250 words.
- **Prize**  
Win a class visit by a volunteer who has worked in Africa and cool gear from Mountain Equipment Coop  
Two runner-up prizes of EWB-MEC gift packs will also be awarded.

## **Intermediate Category – Grades 9, 10, 11**

- **Who?**  
Open to students in grades 9, 10, 11
- **What?**  
Share your vision of a better world through images. Answer the question “What kind of world do you want to live in and what will it take to get there?” through the series of photographs or a collage and through captions of up to 75 words per photo.  
Or...film a 2 minute video answering the question “What kind of world do you want to live in and what will it take to get there?”. You can also include a 250 word write-up explaining the video.
- **Prize**  
Win a personalized video from a volunteer who has worked in Africa and cool gear from Mountain Equipment Coop  
Two runner-up prizes of EWB-MEC gift packs will also be awarded.

## **Senior Category – Grade 12**

- **Early Bird Contest**  
Win a trip to the Engineers Without Borders National Conference in Mississauga in January 2009! Submit your entry by **January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009** for your chance to win the early bird prize.
