Guidelines for participants

1. World Youth Alliance welcomes participants between the age of 19 to 30 * who believe in our mission to 'promote Human Dignity and build solidarity among youth from developed and developing nations to impact culture and policy' to this conference.
2. Participants are required to fill in the training conference application form **fully** by 29th June 2009. The form is available from the World Youth Alliance website <http://www.wya.net>. All fully filled application forms should be sent to africa@wya.net or dropped to the WYA Africa office
3. Participants are required to fundraise for their tickets to and from the conference. World Youth Alliance will work towards providing modest accommodation and meals for participants for the duration of conference only.
4. Registration fee per participant for the conference is KES 2500 (apprx 30 USD) payable in cash on arrival. There is an option of early bird registration fee of KES 2000 (apprx 25 USD) for those who pay by **29th June 2009**. The registration fee covers training materials and certificates.
5. There exists a limited number of scholarships for a waiver of the registration Fee to those who provide proof they are in need**
6. Participants are advised to register for the WYA online training programme whose deadline is on 29th May 2009. Those wishing to take part in training should send an Email to hezbon@wya.net
7. All participants should confirm their attendance by sending their complete application forms to the WYA Africa Regional staff by **Friday 17th July 2009**.
8. All confirmed participants will be Emailed copies of conference preparation reading materials three weeks prior to the conference. All are expected to read through in order to participate fully in the conference.
