Background

The theme of World AIDS Day 2009 is Human Rights and Universal Access. To integrate human rights into the HIV and AIDS response among young people in different countries with different contexts, it's important to encourage partners at the country level to design and implement World AIDS Day campaigns with country specific characteristics and the new theme Human Rights and Universal Access.

The World AIDS Campaign constituency programme conducted a big campaign in India in the World AIDS Day 2008, which was successful. To continue adding value at the World AIDS Day 2009 with the new theme Human rights and Universal Access at country level, we aim to partner with 5-6 youth led youth serving organisations from 5 different regions to developed WAD events at national level in 2009, highlighting the theme Human Rights and Universal Access in their country context.

To support this work, we are seeking an intern that will work in close collaboration with the Youth Campaigns Coordinator, to support the work of our youth partners in this regard.

Goal of Internship

Support the World AIDS Campaign youth programme in the World AIDS Day youth campaigns 2009 in partnerships with different partners.

Role and Responsibilities

- A) Coordinate with partner organisations for the World AIDS Day campaigns with the theme Human Rights and Universal Access.
- B) Provide support and assistance to partner organisations about the preparation of the campaigns, as well as the messages partner organisations develop for the campaigns.
- C) Coordinate with partner organisations and the World AIDS Day Coordinator of the World AIDS Campaign to develop the World AIDS Day materials and other resources based on the World AIDS Campaign World AIDS Day materials.
- D) Conduct evaluations after the World AIDS Day campaigns with partner organisations, including developing the evaluation forum.
- E) Collect reports, photographs and related materials from partner organisations after the World AIDS Day campaigns, and develop a final report for the World AIDS Day campaigns.
- F) Other tasks as requested by the Youth Campaign Coordinator.
- G) All of the email communications need to copy the Youth Campaign Coordinator in for backup. All decisions need to be made with the Youth Campaign Coordinator.
- H) The Internship needs to keep the World AIDS Day Coordinator of the World AIDS Campaign updated of the youth programme World AIDS Day Campaigns process with a regular base.

Competencies:

1. Have experience working with young people;
2. Good English skills, including written, spoken and listening;
3. Strong organisational skills with an attention to detail and ability to multi-task;
4. Ability to work efficiently under pressure both independently and as a member of a team;
5. Ability to work in an international and multicultural environment;
6. Excellent coordination skills;
7. Have good understanding of the World AIDS Day;

8. Have good understanding of the youth movement in HIV and AIDS field at different level;
9. Computer skills including internet navigation and various office applications.

Above all else: This post requires sensitivity and humility. We are a world campaign of other people's voices. This entails listening to the priorities and concerns of World AIDS Campaign's partners, and responding appropriately in a way that often promotes other organisations' efforts over our own World AIDS Campaign brand and profile.
