Introduction to Impactful Practices for Working with Youth

This training focuses on staff capacity building to work with youth with an emphasis on those from priority Neighbourhoods; youth population of our community who have been marginalized by one or more of the following identities: gender, race, age, physical or mental ability, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion/ faith, family status, language ability, literacy, socio-economic status, immigration/refugee status and country of origin.

This **Introduction to Impactful Practices for Working with Youth** training will work towards enhancing the capacity of frontline staff to provide equitable and accessible, competent and appropriate support services to the diverse youth population of students on within priority communities.

Participants will:

- Increase their level of understanding and awareness about current youth trends with priority neighborhoods
- Increase their levels understanding and awareness about principles in working with youth with an emphasis on youth in priority neighborhood
- Acquaint staff/participants with tools, strategies and ideas for successfully engaging youth and implementing practices that's effective working with youth

This one-day training is based on adult education principles, and will utilize didactic and audio visual presentations, small and large group discussions, and experiential learning methods. The training will enhance participants understanding of the effective principles in working with diverse youth.
